## **Guideline:**

- 1. Per Division of Professional Regulation requirements, licensees prescribed medication assisted treatment (MAT) while stabilizing in treatment may enroll and participate in DPHMP.
- Licensees who wish to continue to work, return to work, and/or seek employment while taking a
  MAT will have their case reviewed to determine appropriateness and safety before returning to
  work.
- 3. DPHMP will take into consideration the medical recommendation of the licensee's prescribing physician and/or third-party evaluator.
- 4. It is preferred that the prescribing physician is a psychiatrist or board certified in addiction with awareness of the licensee's work history, workplace setting, responsibilities, and access to medications.
- 5. Licensee may be required to complete a third-party evaluation prior to returning to work.
- 6. If allowed to return to work while on MAT, licensee must remain under prescribing physician care and provide required medication management forms as described in the licensee's monitoring addendum.
